## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

### PROPOSED ADOPTION OF THE INTENDED USE PLAN (IUP) FOR THE CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF) FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 2013

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will consider adopting the FFY 2013 IUP for the CWSRF Program at the Tuesday, November 20, 2012, Board Meeting.

#### BACKGROUND

The CWSRF Program provides low-cost financing for construction of wastewater treatment and recycling facilities, implementation of non-point source (NPS) and storm water projects, and development and implementation of estuary conservation and protection efforts.

The IUP is required by federal statutes and regulations. It is included in the capitalization grant application submitted yearly to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA). The FFY 2013 IUP outlines the State Water Board's business plan and funding available for the CWSRF Program during FFY 2013. It identifies the projects the State Water Board anticipates financing during FFY 2013, the associated financing terms, and the performance measures that will be used to track the CWSRF Program.


### **PARKING AND ACCESSIBILITY**
