<b>6020</b>	<b>State Revolving Fund Loan Subaccount</b>  To aid in the construction or implementation of eligible projects as specified in the Water Code, Section 79124.
<b>6051</b>	<b>Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Fund of 2006</b>  Funds projects relating to safe drinking water, water quality and supply, flood control, waterway and natural resource protection, water pollution and contamination control, state and local park improvements, public access to natural resources, and water conservation efforts. Provides funding for emergency drinking water, and exempts such expenditures from public contract and procurement requirements to ensure immediate action for public safety.
