

Watershed Restoration Plans and Legacy Site Inventories

Within 6 months of adoption of this Waiver, each national forest shall provide to the Executive Director of the State Water Board for inclusion in Attachment B to this Waiver, a list of existing and planned watershed restoration plans, including the watershed name and the date the watershed restoration plan (including legacy site identification, prioritization, and scheduling) was completed or is scheduled for completion. This list shall be updated annually.
