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# NOTICE OF BOARD MEETING

## Proposed Policy for Implementation of Toxics Standards for Inland Surface Waters, Enclosed Bays, and Estuaries of California

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a meeting will be held by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) to consider adoption of the proposed State policy for water quality control titled "Policy for Implementation of Toxics Standards for Inland Surface Waters, Enclosed Bays, and Estuaries of California" (proposed Policy). The purpose of the proposed Policy is to establish: (1) statewide implementation provisions for priority toxic pollutant standards; and (2) statewide toxicity control provisions. The proposed Policy represents Phase 1 in a two-phase process to adopt a new Inland Surface Waters Plan (ISWP) and Enclosed Bays and Estuaries Plan (EBEP).

# **NOTE:** Adoption of the proposed Policy is contingent on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's prior promulgation of the California Toxics Rule.

### AVAILABILITY OF DOCUMENTS AND OTHER INFORMATION

A third public draft of the proposed Policy is being revised in response to public comments received on the November 12, 1999 draft. The revised draft Policy will be available for public review on during the week of January 3 10, 2000. The accompanying November 12, 1999 Functional Equivalent Document (FED) is still available; revisions to the draft FED will be released as soon as they are available. If written comments are submitted electronically, they must be submitted in one of the following formats, listed in order of preference:
