What good is a caddis fly?

Despite their small size, insects like caddis flies play a big role in the livelihood of a stream. Trout and other fish nibble on the wormlike young or gorge on the winged adults. Unfortunately, the insects are among the first to disappear when a stream or forest surrounding it are disturbed.

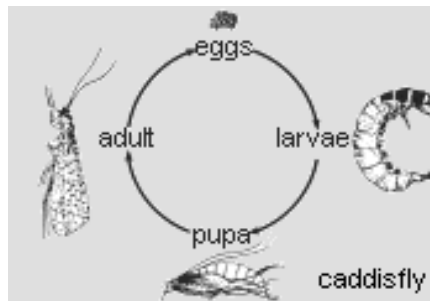
