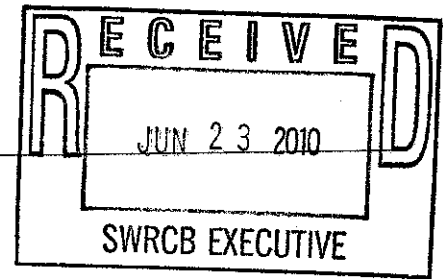

This is a response/comment to the "Proposed approval of an amendment to the water quality control plan for the Los Angeles region to prohibit on-site wastewater disposal in the Malibu Civic Center area

Gentlemen – I am a retired attorney with significant experience in the environmental engineering field. I also live in the Malibu Knolls area.

- There is no evidence that the homes in the Malibu Knolls are contributing to the groundwater pollution problems in the Civic Center area.
- You seem unwilling to wait for the results of studies in the Malibu Civic Center area which the LA WQCB itself has requested.
- The fact that you are unwilling to wait for the results of the studies tells me that you seek to include the Malibu Knolls area in the septic prohibition area for purely political reasons in order to increase the possible assessment base.
- Malibu is a mixed community. Not everyone is fabulously wealthy. The Malibu Knolls area is populated primarily by retirees living on a fixed income. I include myself in this group.
- Subjecting the Malibu Knolls residents to an unwarranted waste water disposal assessment is tantamount to a confiscation of property.

I strongly object to the inclusion of the Malibu Knolls area in the septic ban.
