OPINION

Application 8732 is a refiling of Application 6252, which after
a hearing upon the protests was cancelled on March 31, 1936, on the ground
that there was a lack of unappropriated water. Applicant refiled in the
expectation that an arrangement could be consummated with the protestants
who hold prior and existing rights upon the stream whereby it would be
permitted to share in the waters of this source. Applicant has, however,
been unsuccessful in its effort to consummate such an arrangement and the

parties stipulated to stand upon the showing which was made at the time of the hearing upon Application 6252. There having been no further showing and the situation being unchanged so far as this office is advised, it is concluded as before that there is insufficient unappropriated water in this source to justify approval of Application 8732.

ORDER

Application 8732 for a permit to appropriate water having been filed with the Division of Water Resources, as above stated, protests having been filed, a public hearing having been held and the Division now being fully informed in the premises it is hereby ordered that Application 8732 be rejected and cancelled upon the records of the Division of Water Resources.
