ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

BY THE BOARD

WHEREAS:

1. In February 1978, South Cloverdale Water Company filed an application to appropriate 0.29 cubic foot per second by direct diversion from January 1 to December 31 from Russian River underflow for domestic purposes.

2. The project contemplated in Application 25682 is for additional water to serve a small subdivision which is partly served with the present system under License 5767 (Application 14045).

3. The new application requires a water system permit from Sonoma County, which is being held up until the State Department of Health completes a report on the project which has not yet reached the Applicant.

4. The report has been completed and should reach the applicant soon.

5. Staff has previously granted applicant an extension until April 5, 1979, to resolve difficulties with Sonoma County Public Health Service.

6. Applicant has requested another extension until October 5, 1979 because the report may affect the project as described in the Application.

7. It is the policy of the Board to grant extensions of time where the applicant demonstrates due diligence in pursuing his permit where delays are caused by reasons beyond applicant's control.

8. The applicant has had difficulty in obtaining required reports and permits from governmental agencies.

9. Indefinite delay cannot be approved.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. The applicant be granted an extension of time until October 5, 1979, to complete application.

2. That failure of applicant to complete application by October 5, 1979 will result in cancellation of Application 25682 without further processing.
