Dear Ms. Baer:

A copy of the excerpted portion of the USGS 7.5 Minute Series Map, a map of the relevant portion of the Marsh-Phillips (South Cowell) Ranch, and a page of defined areas of use and the nature of the use will have been delivered to POST by September 30, 2004. I have completed all mapping and I have been able to coordinate township and range coordinates with the USGS topographic map. In a nutshell, the application will be supplemented with the use of the reservoir for stock watering and occasional drip irrigation, as follows:

### DEFINED AREA

"Irrigable Lands" are lands upon which rotational crops are grown and cattle are grazed. The lands are further defined as a portion of the Purisima Rancho, consisting of the land lying west of Verde Road and east of the Pacific Ocean, containing approximately 245 acres. Specifically, Irrigable Lands consist of and are found within the following:

- (1) 15 acres contained in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec.21, T6S, R5W;
- (2) 35 acres contained in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec.21, T6S, R5W;
- (3) 40 acres contained in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec.21, T6S, R5W;
- (4) 30 acres contained in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec.21, T6S, R5W;
- (5) 20 acres contained in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec.21, T6S, R5W;
- (6) 25 acres contained in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec.21, T6S, R5W; and,
- (7) 20 acres contained in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 28, T6S, R5W;
- (8) 30 acres contained in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 28, T6S, R5W;
- (9) 30 acres contained in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 28, T6S, R5W.

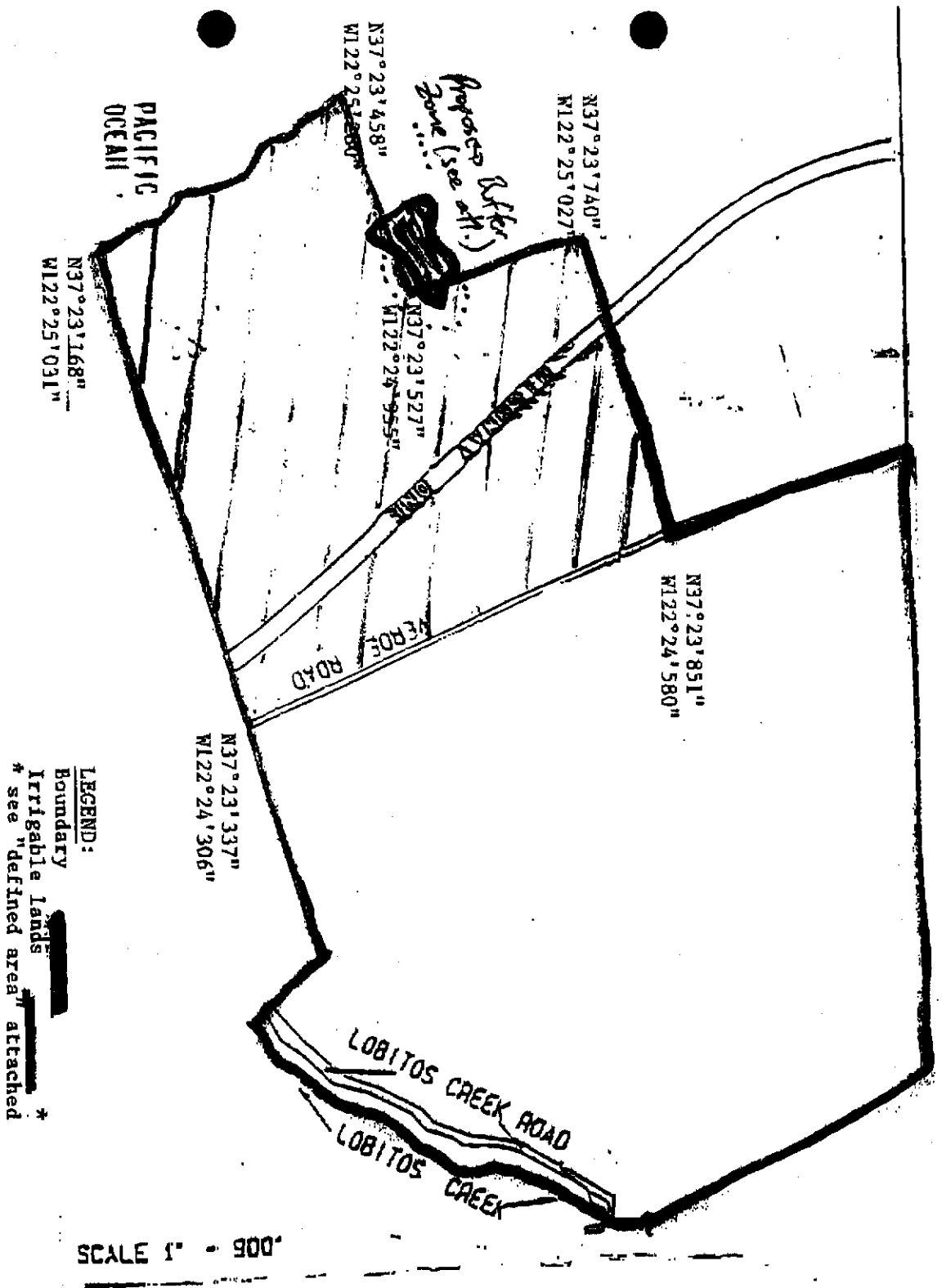

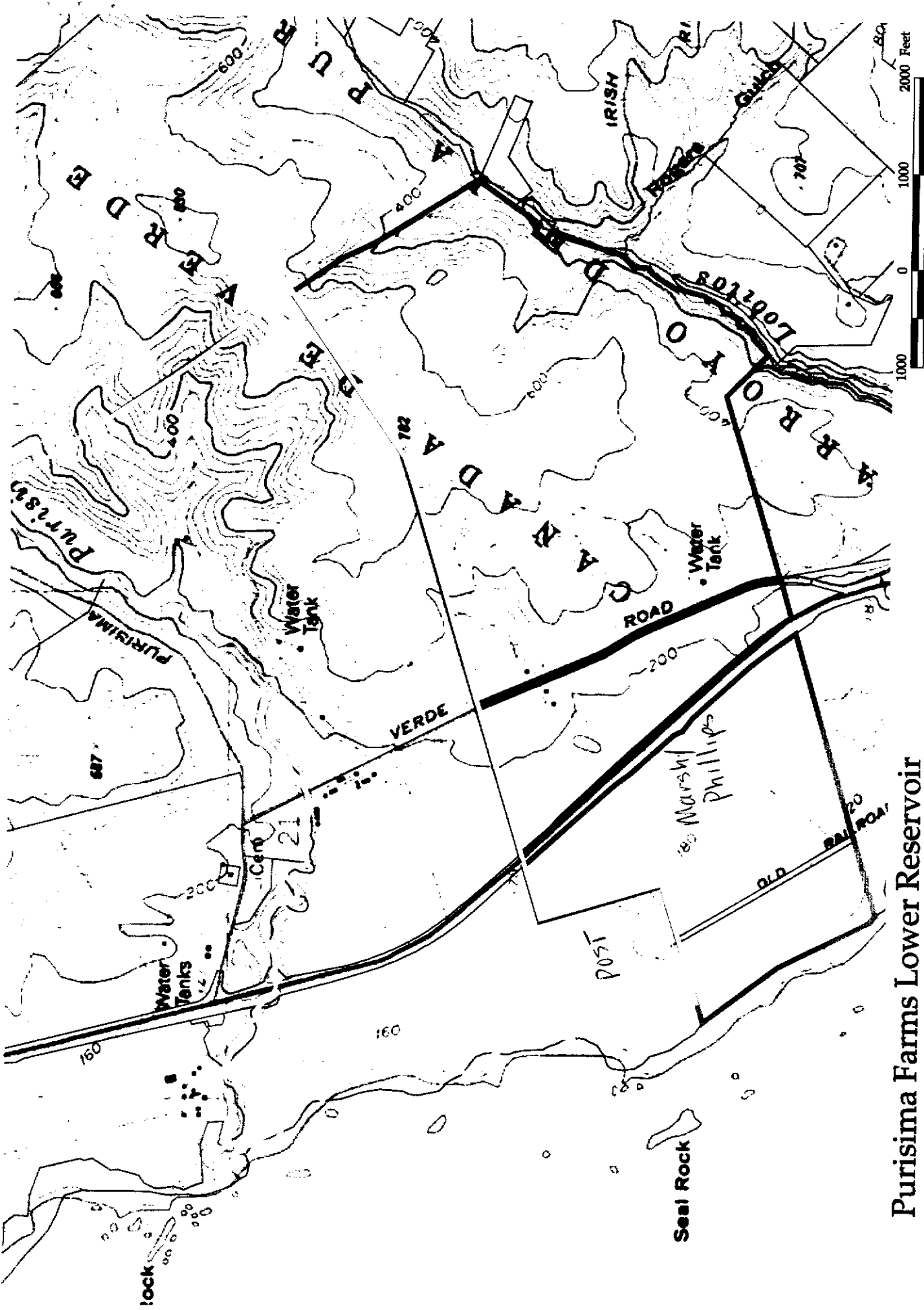
# Purisima Farms

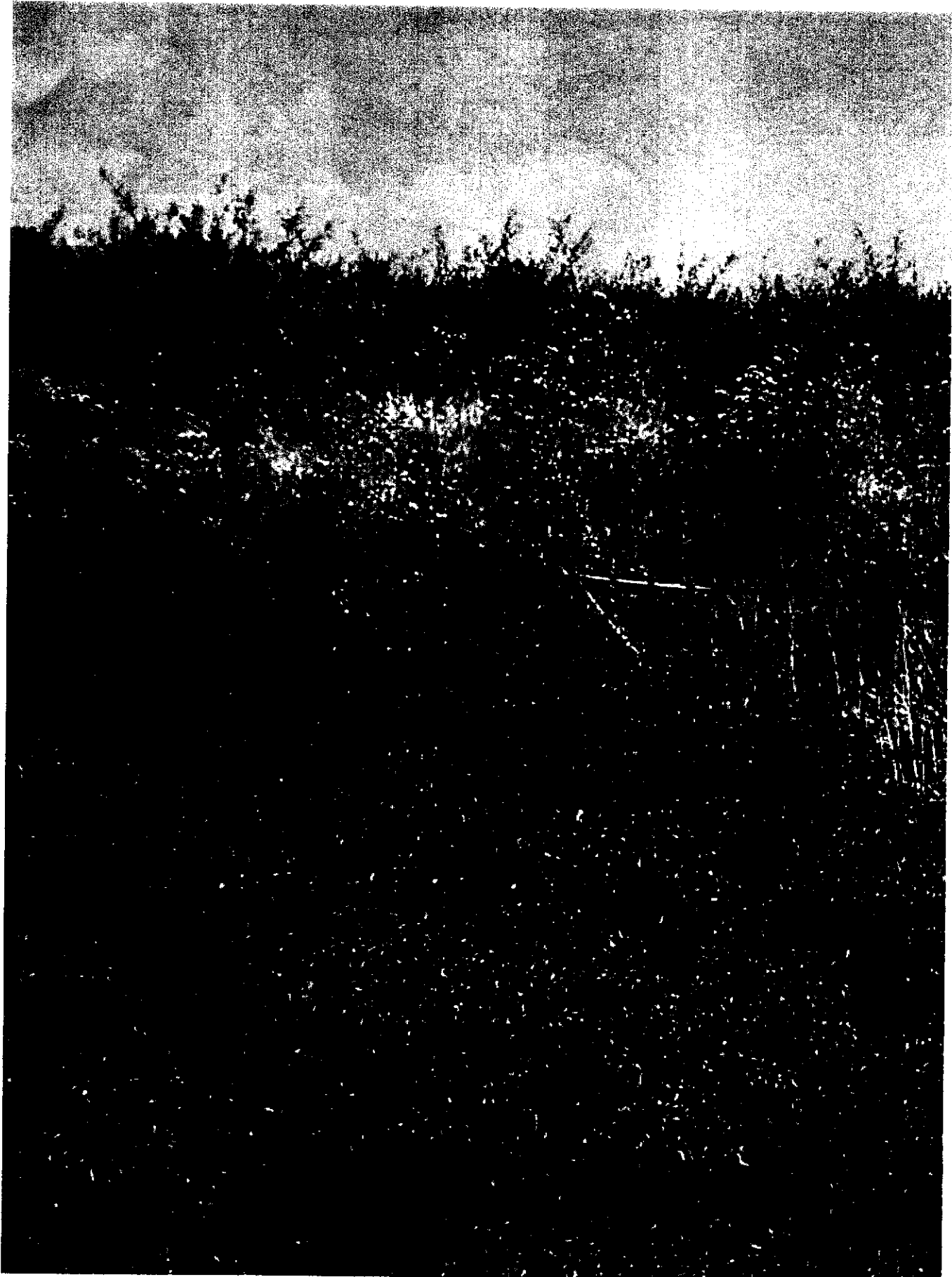
