Petitioner also intends to move the proposed onstream reservoir site to a
more environmentally friendly location. The existing reservoir site is
located onstream in a wetland area and the new offstream location is in an
adjacent cleared area. The Petitioner proposes to use an offset well at
the existing point of diversion to pump water to the proposed offstream
"pit-type" reservoir. The proposed offstream site is located in a
naturally cleared area. No trees or shrubs will be removed pursuant to
Application 30223 or this Petition.


