NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0054

COUNTY: San Mateo STREAM SYSTEM: Calera Creek

Calera Creek Recycling/WWTP, 700 Coast Highway, Pacifica California 94044 has filed a wastewater change petition, seeking to change the place of use, purpose of use, and reduce the discharge quantity of treated wastewater by 0.46 cubic foot per second (cfs), with an annual limit of 336 acre feet (af).
