NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0060

COUNTY: Siskiyou County STREAM SYSTEM: Lost River

City of Tulelake, Box 847, 591 Main Street, Tulelake, CA, 96134 has filed a wastewater change petition, seeking to change the point of discharge, purpose of use, place of use, and discharge quantity of treated wastewater to use 0.248 cubic foot per second (cfs) for land application/evaporation/treatment within the SE ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 1, T47N, R4E, MDB&M.

Summary of Existing Discharge and Proposed Changes:

Point of Discharge	Present: Discharge to Tulelake Irrigation District's (TID) Drain No. 44-B-1 at NAD 83, Zone 1, North 2,593,601 feet and East 6,705,446 feet, being within NE ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 1, T47N, R4E, MDB&M; Proposed: Discharge to proposed 40 acre evaporation pond/wetland at NAD 83, Zone 1, North 2,593,175 feet and East 6,706,038 feet, being within SE ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 1, T47N, R4E, MDB&M;
Place of Use	Present: TID Drain 44 – B1 Proposed: Proposed 40 acre evaporation pond/wetland
Purpose of Use	Present: Discharge into drainage ditch hydraulically connected to Tulelake-Lower Klamath Lake reach of the Lost River Basin Proposed: Evaporative pond/constructed wetland treatment
Discharge Quantity	Present: 0.248 cubic foot per second (cfs) Proposed: 0
Season:	January 1 through December 31 of the succeeding year
