NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0081 FOR CITY OF WOODLAND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY

COUNTY: Yolo

STREAM SYSTEM: Tule Canal

The City of Woodland has filed a wastewater change petition, seeking to reduce the discharge of treated wastewater from its Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF) to the Tule Canal tributary to the Sacramento River. With the petition, the City requests to deliver up to 0.5 million gallons per day (mgd) of its tertiary treated wastewater effluent to industrial use and landscape irrigation. Summary of Wastewater Discharge

Point of Discharge	Treated wastewater effluent is discharged to Tule Canal at Latitude 38° 40' 54" N and Longitude 121° 38' 42" W (NAD83 Zone 2, North 2,010,280 feet, East 6,662,976 feet)
Purpose of Use:	Present: average dry weather discharge of up to six (6) mgd of treated wastewater effluent to Tule Canal Proposed: deliver up to approximately 0.5 mgd of treated wastewater for industrial use and landscape irrigation to properties northwest of the WPCF
Place of Use:	Proposed: Industrial use at the Woodland Biomass Power facility and Irrigation uses at two City parks
Discharge Season:	January 1 to December 31 of each year
