### NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE FOR PERMIT 21112 (APPLICATION 5645B)

COUNTIES: AMADOR, ALPINE, STREAM SYSTEM: SILVER LAKE, CAPLES LAKE,  
AND EL DORADO LAKE ALOHA, SOUTH FORK  
AMERICAN RIVER

EFFECTIVE DATE: 180 days from issuance of order on petition.

The petition requests authorization to temporarily store 4,000 acre-feet (af) of water released from Caples Lake in Jenkinson Lake by (1) adding Jenkinson Lake as a temporary place of storage; (2) adding a point of redirection at Sly Park Dam (which forms Jenkinson Lake); (3) adding a point of redirection at El Dorado Canal to convey water from South Fork American River to Jenkinson Lake; (4) providing relief from permit condition 9 regarding maintenance of Caples Lake at specified levels for recreational purposes during the recreation season; and (5) providing relief from permit condition 12 regarding the bypass, release, and lake capacity requirements imposed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) license for Project 184.

Place of Use:	Within the service area of El Dorado Irrigation District, excluding Service Zones 9, 14 and 15.
