NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF 7,175 ACRE FEET OF WATER FROM RECLAMATION DISTRICT NO. 1004 TO THE SAN LUIS AND DELTA-MENDOTA WATER AUTHORITY UNDER LICENSE 3165 (APPLICATION 27)

On May 3, 2013, Reclamation District No. 1004 (RD 1004) filed a petition for change with the State Water Resources Control Board involving a proposed temporary transfer of 7,175 acre-feet (af) of water to the San Luis and Delta-Mendota Water Authority (Authority) pursuant to Water Code sections 1701 and 1725. The transfer water would be made available by ground water substitution for surface water under RD 1004's license in order to provide an additional supply of water to the Authority for irrigation. The proposed transfer would: 1) add the Central Valley Project's (CVP) Jones Pumping Plant and the State Water Project's Harvey O. Banks Pumping Plant as points of diversion; and 2) add the service area of the CVP as an additional place of use under RD 1004's License 3165. Temporary changes under Water Code section 1725 may be effective for a period of up to one year.
