NOTICE OF TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE PETITION MALACHA HYDRO LIMITED PARTNERSHIP PERMIT 20063 (APPLICATION 28465) DIVERSION FROM PIT RIVER LASSEN COUNTY

On April 4, 2014, Malacha Hydro Limited Partnership (Malacha) filed a Temporary Urgency Change Petition (TUCP) with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights pursuant to California Water Code section 1435, et seq. The requested changes would temporarily add storage as a method of diversion to Permit 20063 and also temporarily reduce minimum instream bypass flows as required pursuant to water right Permit 20063 from 50 cubic feet per second (cfs) to 25 cfs.

Pursuant to California Water Code section 1438(d), any interested person may file an objection to the TUCP. The procedure for addressing an objection is described in Water Code section 1438.
