ORDER

Treated Waste Water Change Petition WW-17

ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND
PURPOSE OF USE OF TREATED WASTE WATER


WHEREAS:

1. Treated Waste Water change petition WW-17 was filed by the City of Visalia on April 20, 1992 pursuant to Sections 1210 and 1211 of the California Water Code.
2. The change petition was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (Board) to obtain Board approval under Sections 1211 and 1700 of the California Water Code to change the Place of Use and Purpose of Use of 2,700 acre-feet of treated waste water discharged to Mill Creek in Tulare County.
3. The Board has determined that good cause for the changes has been shown.
4. The Board has determined that the changes do not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The source of treated waste water shall be from the Visalia Waste Water Treatment Plant, within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 6, T19S, R24E, MDB&M. California Coordinate System: Zone 4, North 356,750, East 1,882,100. (0000001)

2. The Place of Use shall be 900 acres (Walnut irrigation Demonstration Project) adjacent to the Visalia Waste Water Treatment Plant, bordered by 14th Avenue, Watson Road, Highway 99, and on the south by Packwood School; as shown on a map on file with the Board; being within projected Sections 5 and 6, T19S, R24E, MDB&M. 3. The Purpose of Use shall be irrigation. (0000003)
