Dear State Water Board,

Please follow Fish & Game code 5937. It provides for enough water "at all times" for the fish (but also for the wetlands as a whole). When we play with the flow, we are experimenting with changing how mother nature does things. In an ideal case, there would be no impaired flow. Unfortunately, dams are simply environmentally problematic from the getgo. But at the very least, we should follow your board's own report. And keep 50% - 60% of unimpaired flow.

There's a lot of misinformation being touted around. Most of it seems to be generated water agencies and the fear tactics they employ. But you need to do what's best for Californians. Both now, and in consideration of what's best for us over the next couple hundred years.
