I have lived in Fallbrook, CA all my life. I work and raise my family here. We are always very careful about the water we use and don't waste any. In our newspaper it says that you are insisting that everyone in our town cut back our water by 35%. I understand that we will have to do more conserving, but why this much! Our water bill is outrageously high and I have heard that it is because our water agency did a lot of work and things to be sure we would have enough water, even if there was a drought. I know that we have a desal plant going to start up sometime this fall too, so we'll have even more water. This isn't fair that we have paid for all these things to be sure we have water and then you decide we can't use it because other areas of the state have not done the same sort of things. If one of my boys worked hard to get all his homework assignments done and my other son kept putting it off and did not get his work done, I would never punish both boys. That would just be unfair. So why are you punishing San Diego when we're the ones that have done so much to increase our amount of water?
