# Field Investigations to Check Compliance

- Inspections have started:
- Staff contacts diverters to schedule visit
- Inspections are prioritized based on:
  - Size of Diversion
  - Allowable Season
  - Geographic Location and Flow Conditions
  - Responses to Curtailment Cert. Form

# Potential Additional Curtailment Areas

- Russian River
- Sacramento River tributaries
- San Joaquin River and Tributaries
- Eel River tributaries
- Salinas River

## Potential Curtailment Example

- San Joaquin River River:
- Major Reservoirs are releasing stored water
- South Delta Demand under Statements exceeds existing Vernalis flows.
- Riparian demand appears to exceed available natural flow in some tributaries.
