## Re: <u>Pre-Hearing Conference in the Matter of Alleged Unauthorized Diversion by</u> <u>Byron-Bethany Irrigation District</u>

Dear Ms. Farwell-Jensen:

This is in reply to the State Water Resources Control Board (Board) letter of September 11, 2015, regarding the Pre-Hearing Conference in the Matter of Alleged Unauthorized Diversion by Byron-Bethany Irrigation District (BBID). Hearing Officer Tam Doduc invited the parties to comment on the requests for postponement by BBID, Central Delta Water Agency, and South Delta Water Agency (Agencies). The Agencies requested that the hearing on the Board's Administrative Civil Liability complaint against BBID (ENF01951) be stayed or postponed due to pending litigation in Santa Clara County Superior Court, Case No. 1-15-CV-285182 (Curtailment Cases), and to allow additional time for discovery and preparation of testimony. The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) submits the following comments. Although there are many arguments for proceeding with the hearing prior to the Curtailment Cases and there is no legal basis for staying or postponing the hearing, DWR does not oppose the requests that the hearing be delayed in order to allow for sufficient discovery. DWR does, however, oppose any request to postpone the hearing pending the conclusion of the Curtailment Cases.

There is no need to have a lengthy delay, because the scope of the hearing is limited and should not be enlarged. The purpose of the hearing is for the Board to receive evidence relevant to determining: (1) whether BBID engaged in the unauthorized diversion of water; (2) whether to impose administrative civil liability against BBID for the alleged unauthorized diversions; and (3) whether to impose administrative civil liability in the amount of \$1,553,250 or some other amount. The Agencies propose, instead, to have the Board decide broader issues, including water quality, priority of rights, and Delta hydrodynamics, which will include not only the presentation of technical evidence, but also depositions of Board employees and others. This would enlarge the scope of the hearing beyond what is appropriate for a hearing on an Administrative Civil Liability Complaint against one party. Jane Farwell-Jensen September 23, 2015 Page 2

Although the Board is not required to stay or delay the hearing and many arguments support proceeding with the hearing before the substantive issues are heard in the Curtailment Cases, DWR does not oppose the requests that the hearing be delayed for a reasonable, but limited, period of time in order to allow for sufficient discovery. However, DWR opposes postponing the hearing pending resolution of the Curtailment Cases.
