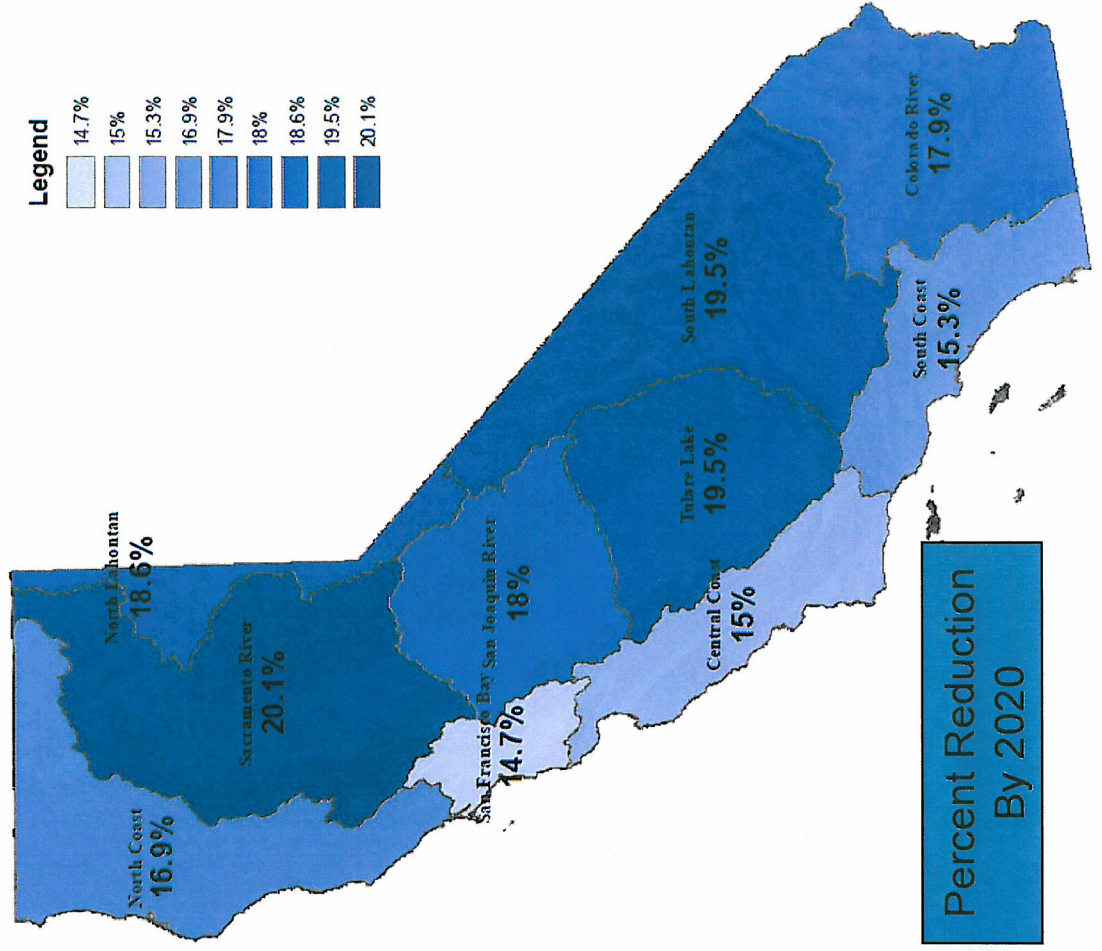
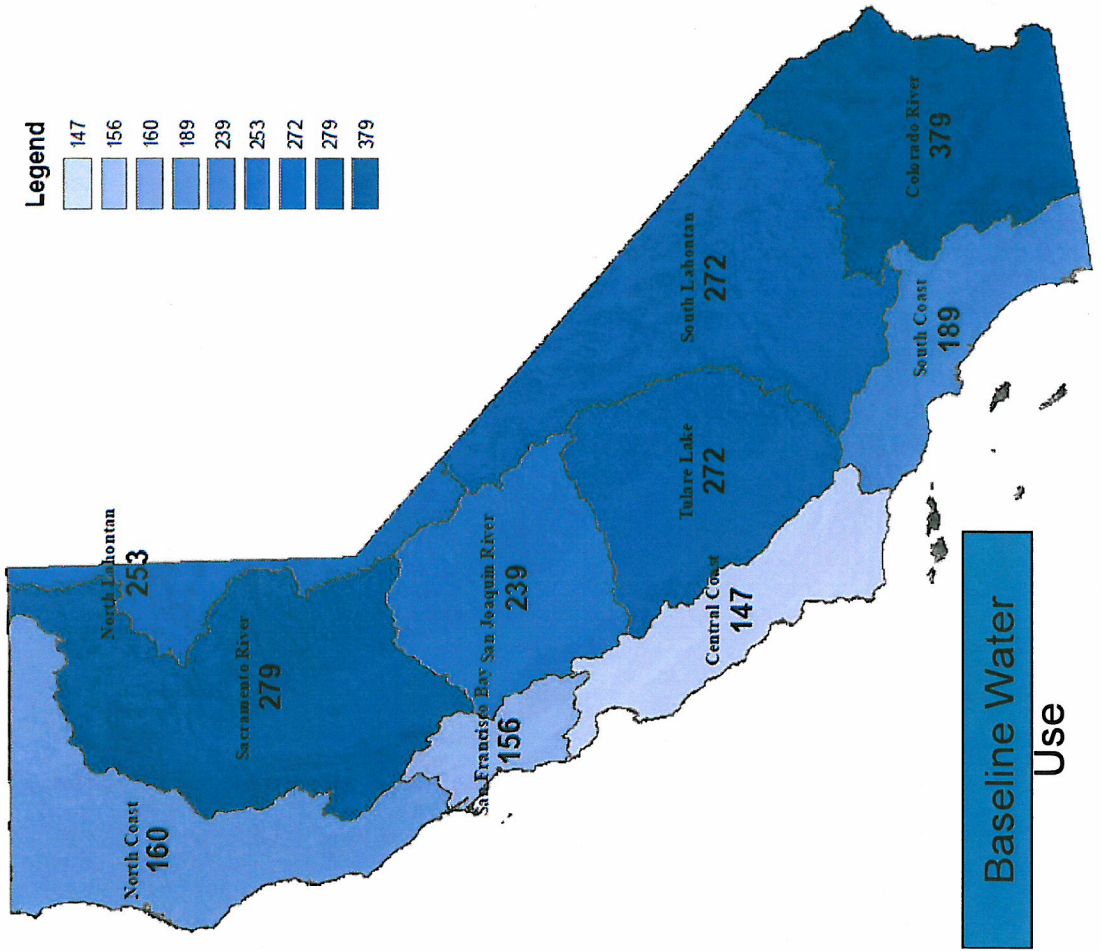

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SBX7-7 Requirements

- SBX7-7 mandates that the state of California as a whole reduce per capita demand 20% by 2020.
- Each “urban retail water supplier” must calculate its own baseline water use and demand reduction targets, and each supplier may have a target that is less than 20%.
- SBX7-7 allows water suppliers to re-assess their baseline and target calculations in 2015 and make adjustments, and also includes the option to change the selected target methodology.
- SBX7-7 applies to per-capita use based on specific mandated calculation methodologies; it does not apply to gross demands of the urban water supplier.

DWR Hydrologic Regions

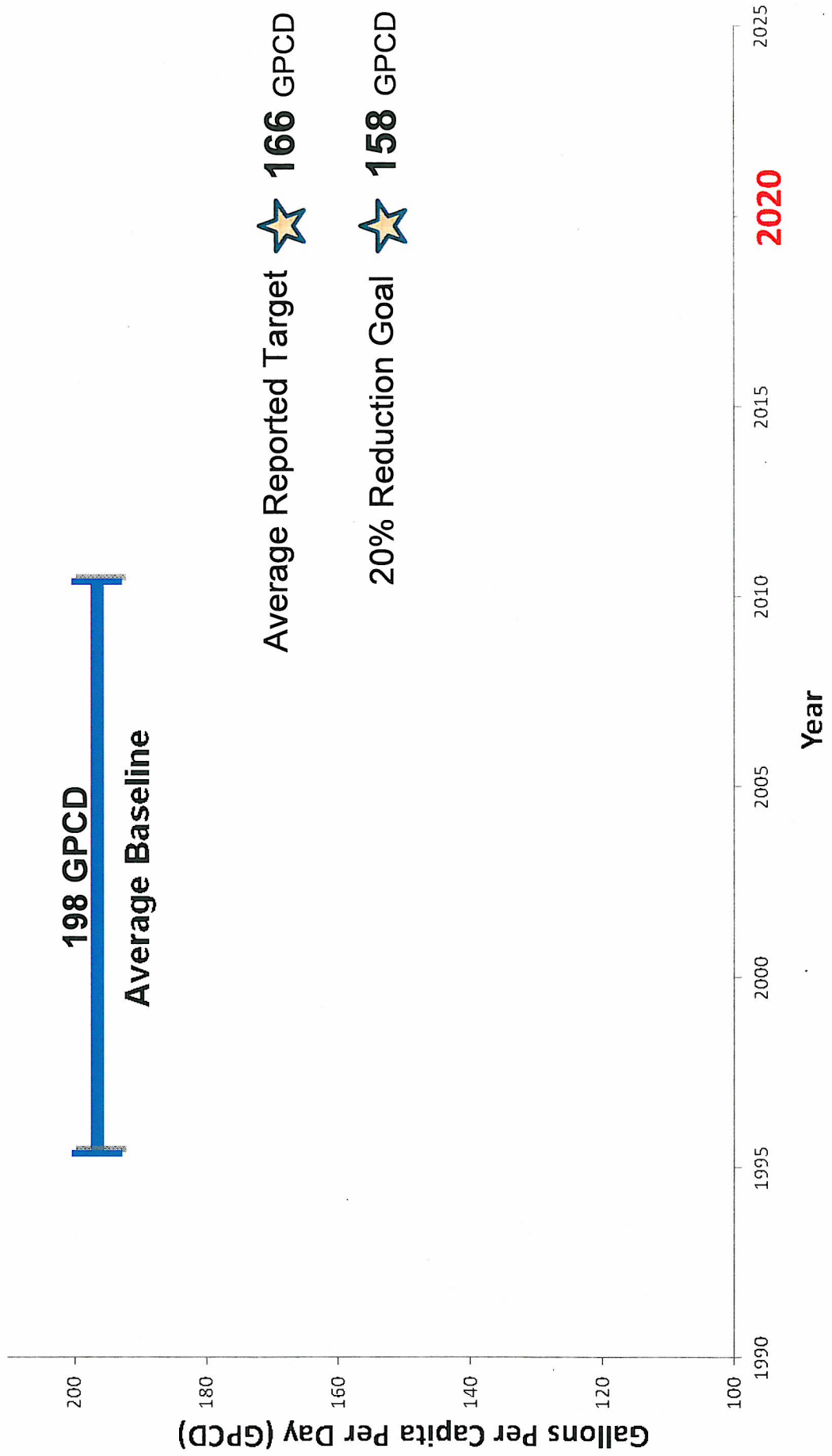

SBx7-7 Compliance Reduction Targets

- Goleta Water District
 - Baseline = 117 gpcd
 - 2015 Target = 115 gpcd
 - 2020 Target = 111 gpcd (5%)
- City of Santa Barbara
 - Baseline = 132 gpcd
 - 2015 Target = 123 gpcd
 - 2020 Target = 117 gpcd (11%)

- **Memorandum Regarding Urban Water Conservation in California (MOU), California Urban Water Conservation Council and cost-effective conservation measures (BMPs)**
