LONG-TERM TRANSFER HEARING – DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES PERMIT 16482 (APPLICATION 17512)

On August 2, 2011, the hearing officer for the Long-Term Transfer Hearing (hearing), scheduled to commence on August 22, 2011, received a letter dated July 29, 2011, from the Department of Water Resources (DWR), Tulare Lake Basin Water Storage District, Empire West Side Irrigation District, and Westlands Water District (Westlands et al.). The letter referred to your July 26, 2011 letter to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) in which the Center for Biological Diversity, California Water Impact Network, California Sportfishing Protection Alliance, and AquAlliance (CBD et al.) indicated their intent to not present a case-in-chief at the upcoming hearing for this matter due to insufficient resources.

The Westlands et al. letter contends that by deciding not to present a case-in-chief, CBD et al. have abandoned their protest and requests that the State Water Board cancel the hearing, dismiss CBD et al.'s protest, and process DWR's petition based upon the information in the State Water Board's records. It is our understanding, per your July 26, 2011 letter, that CBD et al. also reserved the right to appear and perform cross-examination and/or rebuttal testimony at the hearing. Please respond to this letter within 10 days to confirm that CBD et al. intend to participate in the hearing, and do not intend to abandon or withdraw the protest. Per California Code of Regulations section 750, failure to respond to this letter may be interpreted as an abandonment of interest therein.
