**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The goal of the Mill Creek Diversion Structure Removal Project (Project) is to remove El Dorado Irrigation District's diversion structure on Mill Creek. The diversion structure consists of an approximately 17-foot long by 18-inch wide steel reinforced concrete structure that spans Mill Creek. Portions of a slide gate and outlet pipe are also attached to the concrete structure. The Applicant proposes to utilize crews with hand and power tools to remove as much of the diversion structure as possible. All material removed from the diversion structure (approximately 1.1 cubic yards) will be disposed offsite.

The work will be conducted during the low flow season. The Applicant will install a temporary sandbag cofferdam and bypass pipe to route flow around the work area. The total Project size is 0.2 acres and is anticipated to take 5 days to complete.
