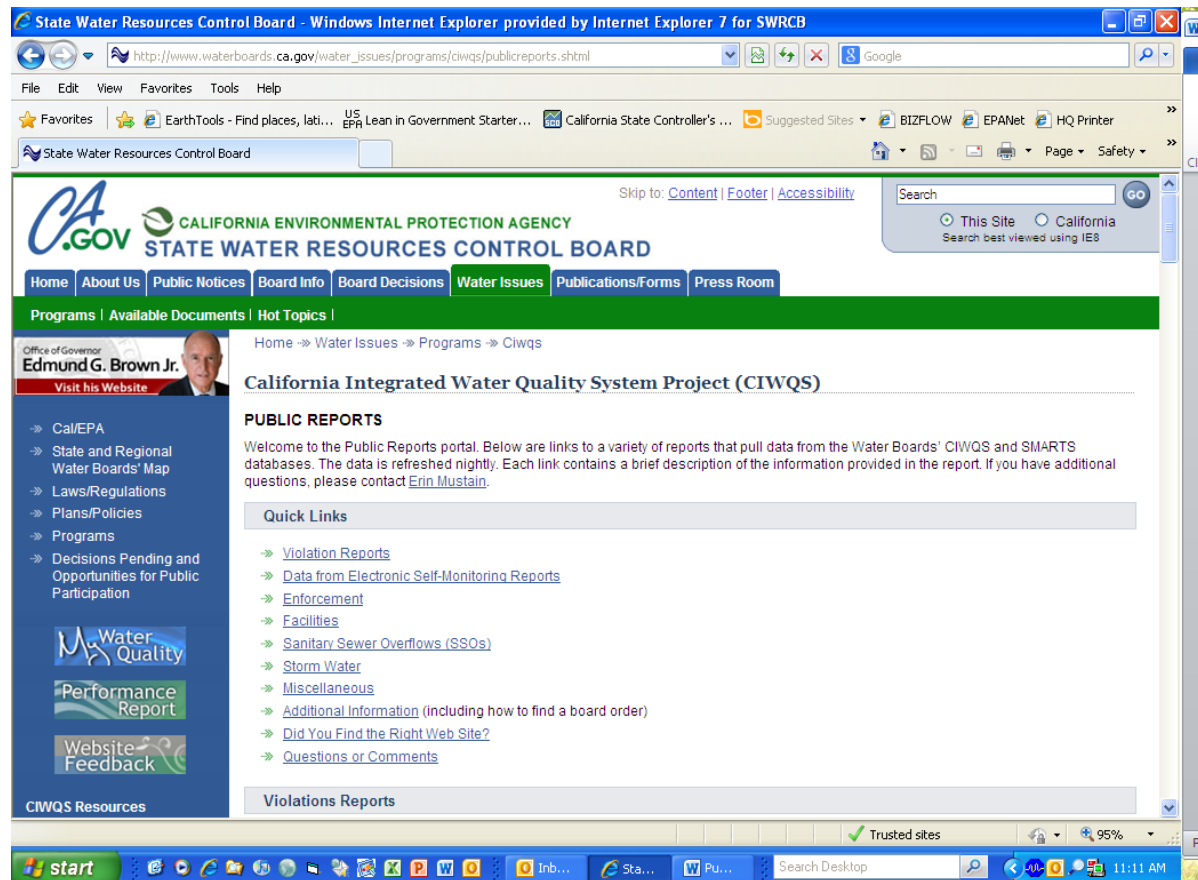

Violations involving recalcitrant parties who deliberately avoid compliance are also considered class 1.

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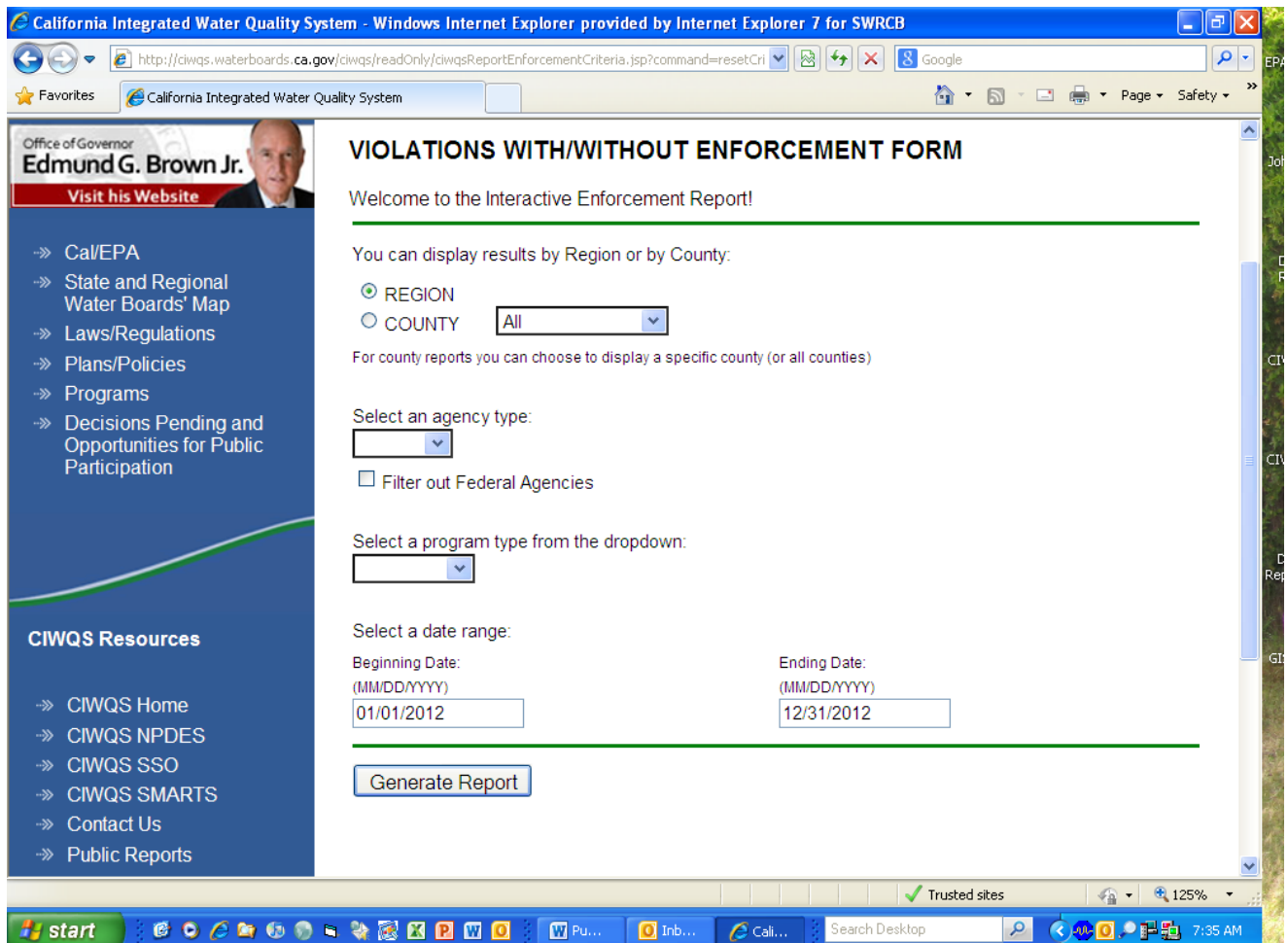

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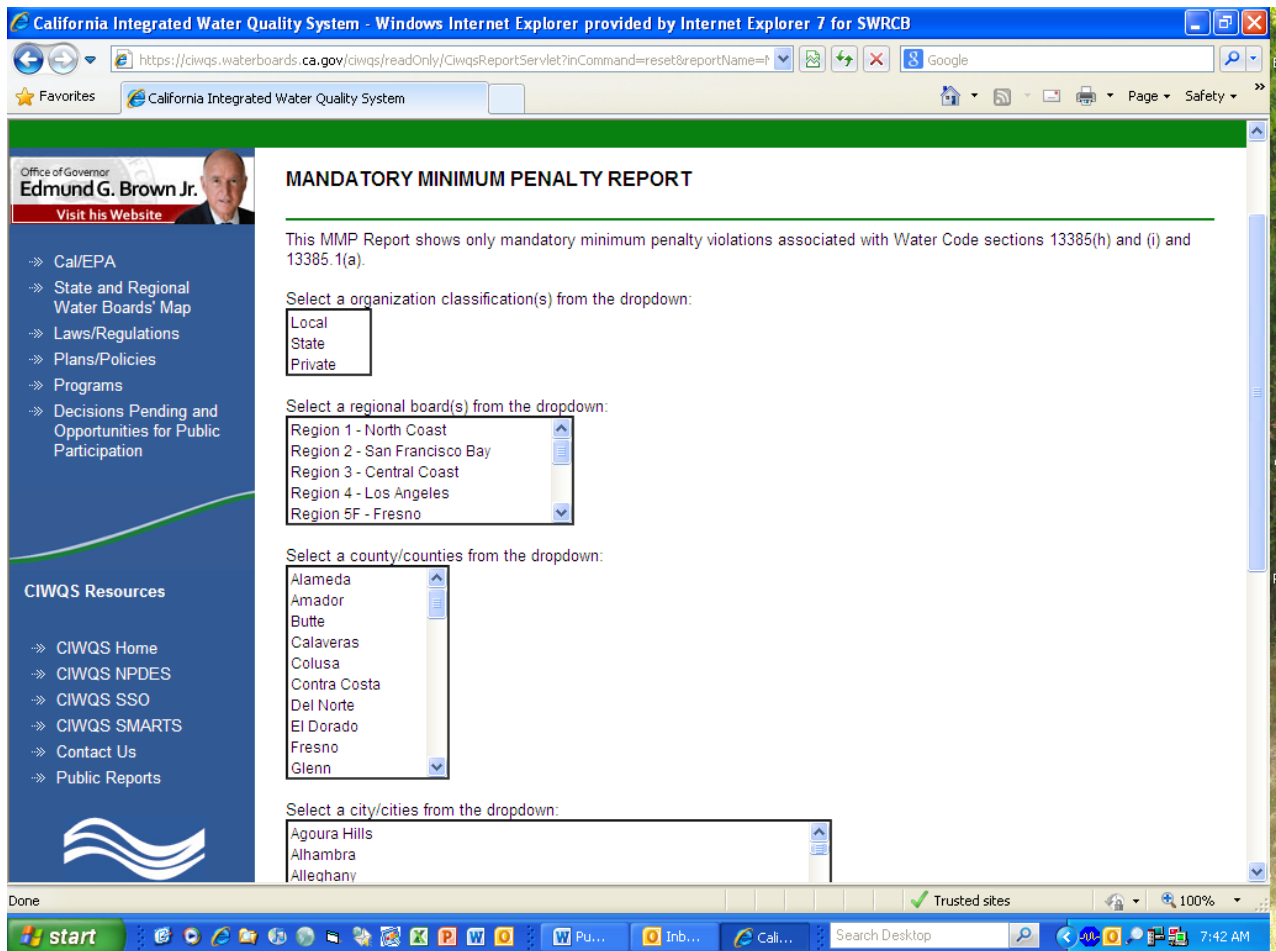
VIOLATION REPORTS

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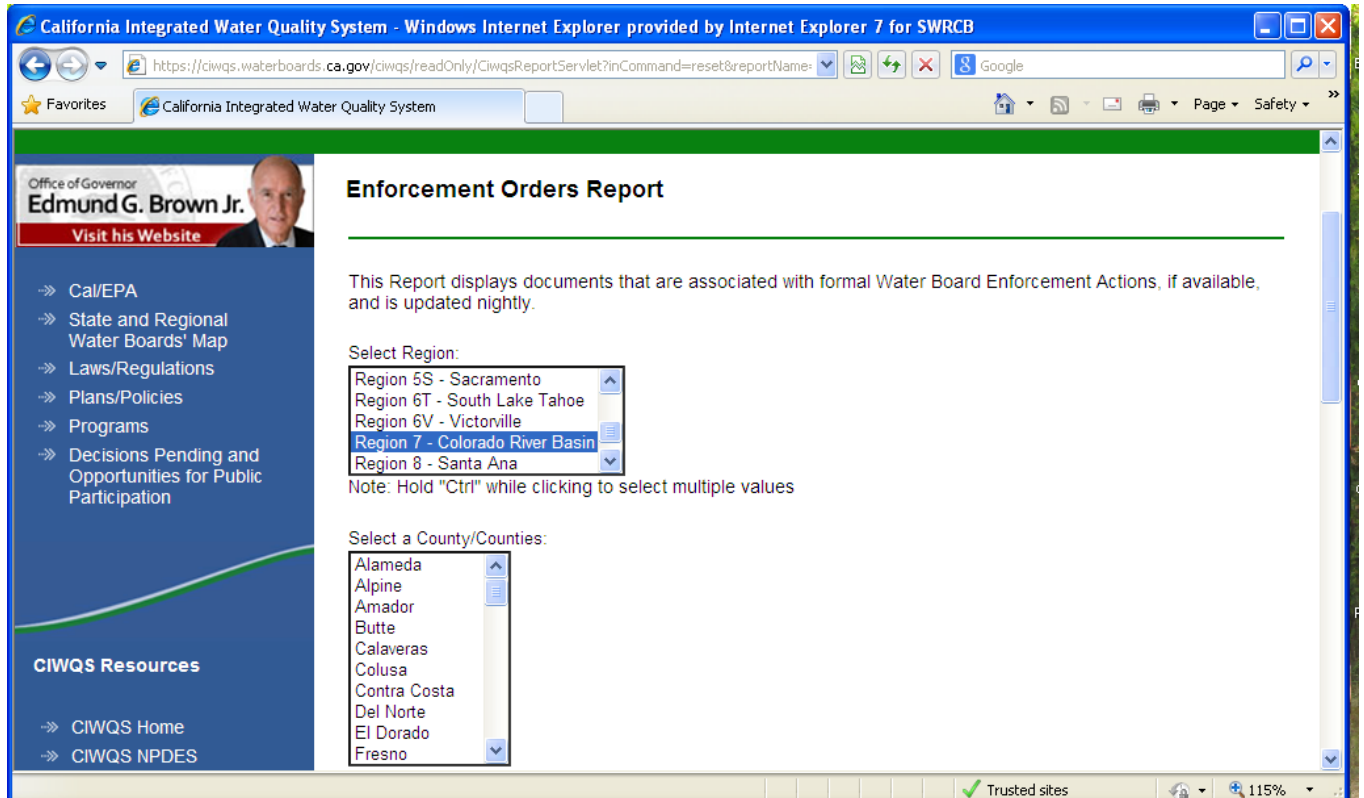

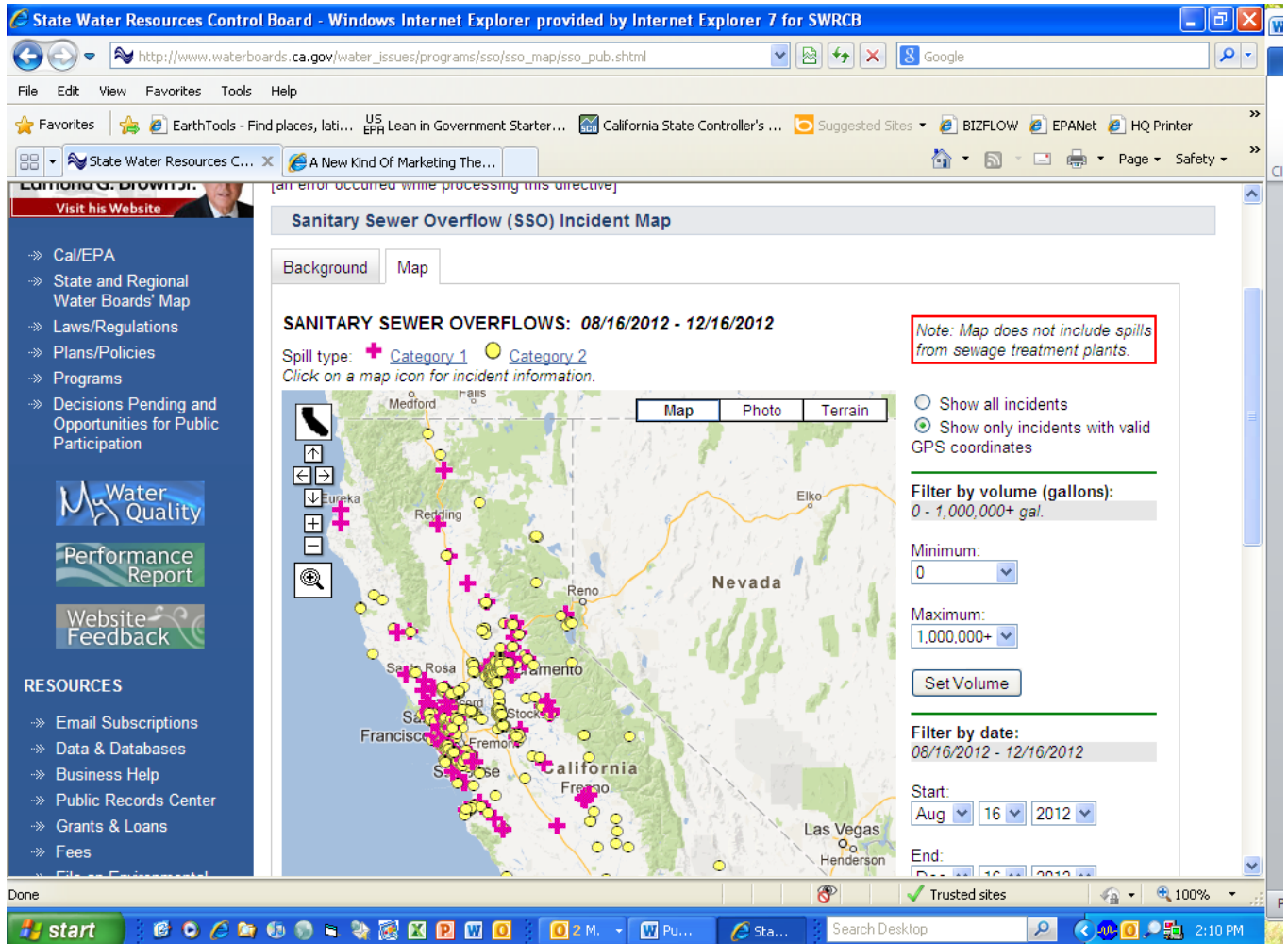

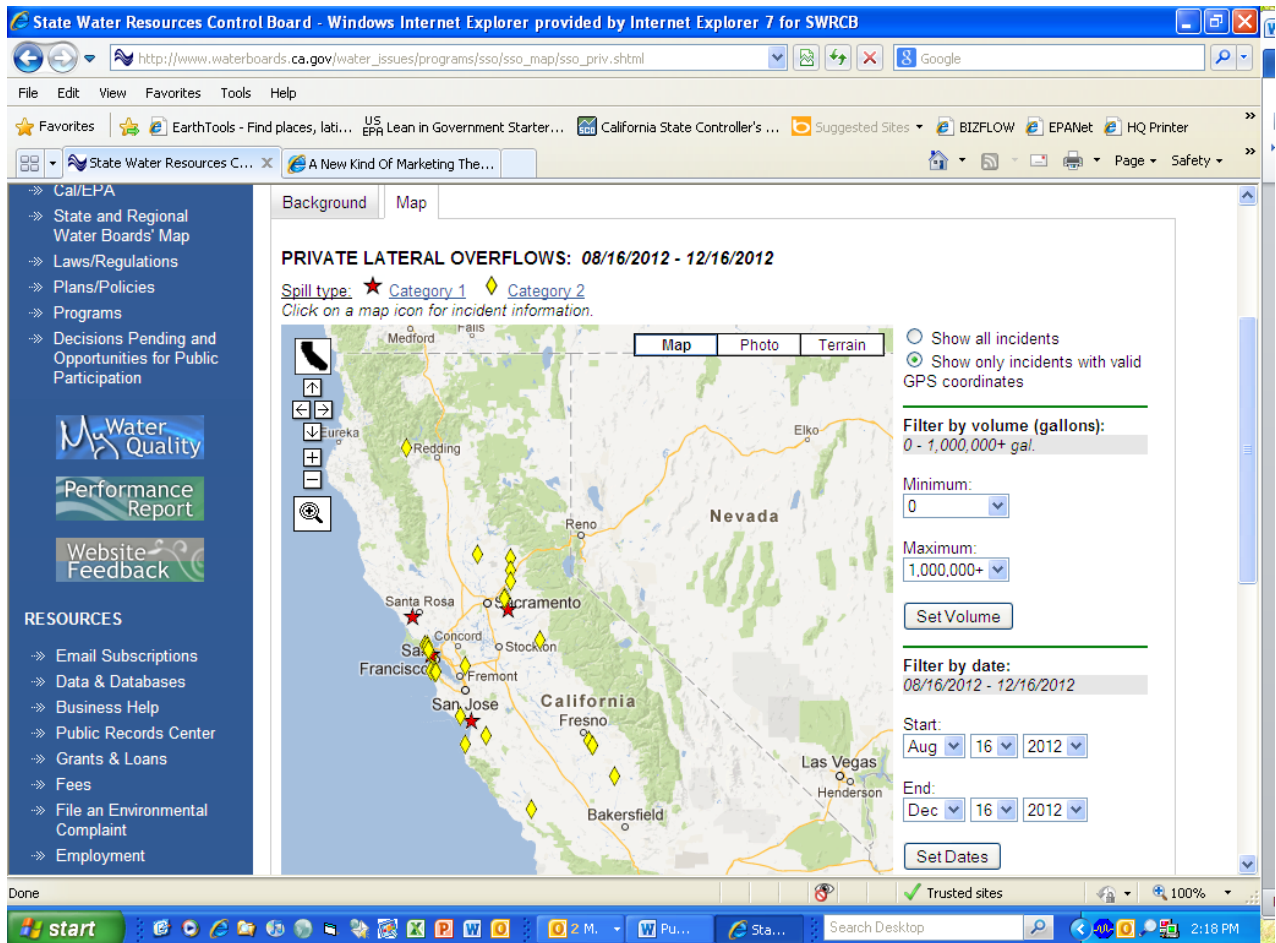
