PROJECT DESCRIPTION: On November 22, 2023, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submitted a request for a water quality certification for the Tiger Creek Regulator Dam Spillway Replacement Project (Project). The Tiger Creek Regulator Dam is a part of PG&E's Mokelumne River Hydroelectric Project (Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Project No. 137). The Project consists of construction of a new spillway intake (crest structure), notch through the existing dam, concrete chute, flip bucket splitter blocks, and plunge pool. Other associated features include a permanent access road, temporary access road, temporary cofferdams, new log boom and anchor blocks, lighting on the dam, and abandonment of the existing spillway.
