

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 74-15

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 73-5 OF THE CENTRAL COAST  
REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD REGARDING REUSE  
OF OIL FIELD WASTES IN THE SANTA MARIA VALLEY

WHEREAS:

1. Regional Water Quality Control Boards may adopt policy guidelines relating to any water quality matter within their jurisdiction.
2. The State Board must approve all such guidelines which implement any action reviewable by the State Board before they become effective.
3. The Central Coast Regional Board's Resolution No. 73-5, Policy Regarding Beneficial Use of Oil Field Waste Materials in the Santa Maria Valley Oil Fields establishes guidelines for actions of the Regional Board pursuant to Water Code Section 13269 and Division 7.5 which are reviewable by the State Board.
4. Resolution No. 73-5 insures the protection of beneficial uses of the waters of the State as required by Division 7 of the Water Code and is in the public interest.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Resolution 73-5 adopted by the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board regarding beneficial reuse of oil field wastes in the Santa Maris Valley is hereby approved by the State Board.
