

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-17

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ISSUED BY THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
FOR CERTAIN DISCHARGES TO THE EASTERN DELTA

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board has adopted waste discharge requirements for the following:

2. After adoption of the above waste discharge requirements, the Federal Water Pollution Control Act and the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act were amended to provide for additional and more stringent limitations.
3. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region has adopted new waste discharge requirements for the following:


