RESOLUTION NO. 75-29

IN THE MATTER OF REVIEW OF ACTIONS OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION REGARDING ADOPTION OF NPDES PERMIT NOS. CA0037761 AND CA0037508 FOR THE CITY OF PITTSBURG, AND THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, CENTRAL VALLEY REGION REGARDING ADOPTION OF NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0079278 FOR THE CITY OF ANTIOCH, AND THE PETITION OF THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR REVIEW OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD ACTION REGARDING THE ADOPTION OF NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0079278 FOR THE CITY OF ANTIOCH

WHEREAS:

1. On October 15, 1974, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region adopted NPDES permit Nos. CA0037761 and CA0037508 prescribing waste discharge requirements for the City of Pittsburg.
2. On December 20, 1974, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region adopted NPDES permit No. CA0079278 prescribing waste discharge requirements for the City of Antioch.
3. On January 15, 1975, the California Department of Fish and Game petitioned the State Board to review the action of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region in adoption of NPDES permit No. CA0079278 prescribing waste discharge requirements for the City of Antioch.
4. On February 6, 1975, it was called to the State Water Resources Control Board's (State Board) attention that certain differences existed between NPDES permit Nos. CA0037761 and CA0037508 for the City of Pittsburg, and the NPDES permit No. CA0079278 for the City of Antioch.
5. The City of Pittsburg and the City of Antioch are adjacent to one another and both discharge into the same reach of the San Joaquin River.
6. It appears to the State Board that the aforementioned actions of the Regional Boards should be reviewed by the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board will review, on its own motion, the aforementioned actions of the California Regional Water Quality Control Boards, for the San Francisco Bay and Central Valley Regions.
