RESOLUTION NO. 75-47

AUTHORIZING A REDUCTION IN THE ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION TO THE WASTEWATER CAPITAL RESERVE FUND (WCRF) FROM \$12,163 to \$2,500 FOR THE TOMALES SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT'S WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS:

1. A serious and documented public health hazard exists as a result of failing septic tanks contaminating local groundwaters.
2. The project will eliminate an existing raw sewage discharge to Tomales Bay.
3. Tomales pursuant to Article 1, Section 3 of the Revenue Program Guidelines (September 1974) has asked the State Board to lower the annual contribution to the Wastewater Capital Reserve Fund from \$12,163 to \$2,500.
4. The proposed lower Wastewater Capital Reserve Fund contribution will still have a significant financial impact on the residents of Tomales where the median annual family income was estimated to be \$7,000 in 1973.
5. The proposed lower Wastewater Capital Reserve Fund contribution will provide an annual amount to the Wastewater Capital Reserve Fund which is sufficient to cover equipment replacement costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the annual contribution to the Wastewater Capital Reserve Fund for the Tomales Sewer Maintenance District's wastewater collection and treatment project be reduced from \$12,163 to \$2,500.
