RESOLUTION NO. 75-50

AUTHORIZING ADJUSTMENT OF PREVIOUSLY APPROVED
STATE WATER QUALITY CONTROL FUND LOAN AMOUNTS.

WHEREAS:

1. The Board on June 1, 1972, adopted Resolution No. 72-32 approving a loan from the State Water Quality Control Fund not to exceed \$112,100 to the Alpine Springs County Water District and Resolution No. 72-33 approving a loan not to exceed \$348,855 to the Squaw Valley County Water District for the cost of interceptor sewers to the Tahoe-Truckee Sanitation Agency sewerage system, and these Districts' shares of the cost of said sewerage system.
2. After the loans to the two Districts were approved three years ago, estimated costs and grant eligibility have changed so that the estimated loan amounts are \$75,000 for Alpine Springs and \$225,000 for Squaw Valley.
3. The indicated excess amount of monies committed from the Fund for these loans could be used for loans for other projects which are nearing readiness for construction, and thereby relieve the need for transfer of monies from the State Clean Water Fund to augment the Loan Fund.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That this Board authorize the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to adjust the previously approved loan amounts to reflect current estimated costs with the loan amounts to be set when the Board considers the loan contracts.
