

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-65

AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH
THE CALIFORNIA POLLUTION CONTROL FINANCING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS:

1. Health and Safety Code Section 39615 provides that no project to construct water pollution control facilities will be eligible for financial assistance from the California Pollution Control Financing Authority unless the State Water Resources Control Board certifies that there is reasonable assurance that (a) the project is necessary to comply further with applicable state and federal standards, and (b) the project is consistent with an approved regional, basin, or state plan for environmental protection.
2. Health and Safety Code Section 39615 also provides that the California Pollution Control Financing Authority shall reimburse the State Water Resources Control Board for making the required certifications.
3. The previous interagency agreement with the California Pollution Control Financing Authority will expire on June 30, 1975, and provision for continuation of the interagency agreement with the Authority should be made.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Water Resources Control Board authorizes its Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to enter into an interagency agreement with the California Pollution Control Financing Authority to provide for compensation to the State Board of the cost involving those certifications required under Health and Safety Code 39615.
