

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-86

REGARDING REQUEST BY INYO COUNTY FOR A WAIVER OF
CLEAN WATER GRANT REGULATIONS TO PERMIT TRUNK SEWER FUNDING

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board by its Order No. 74-3 determined that sewer lines extending north and west of Bishop to six nearby areas were not Class A interceptor sewers and were, therefore, not eligible for grant funding.
2. The six areas in question are delineated on the attached schematic map and numbered 1 through 6.
3. By letter dated May 28, 1975, the Inyo County Administrator requested that the Board nevertheless fund the sewer lines in question because of the financial hardship which would result to local residents should they be required to pay the entire cost of said lines.
4. An analysis of the financial effect of non-eligibility on the six areas in question indicates that failure to provide grant funding for the trunk lines in question would cause severe financial hardship to area 6 (Dixon Lane) but not to the remaining five areas.
5. A serious health hazard has been documented within Inyo County Service Area No. 1, and failure of individual wastewater disposal systems and sewage contamination of groundwater wells used as a domestic water supply has occurred within the Dixon Lane area.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board waive Section 2108(b)(2)(B) of its regulations (Subchapter 7, Chapter 3, Title 23, California Administrative Code) and provide grant funding of the capacity necessary to serve existing residents of the Dixon Lane area in the trunk line extending from Dixon Lane to the Bishop Treatment Plant, with funding to be determined on an incremental cost basis.
2. That funding of trunk sewers not be provided for areas 1 through 5.


