

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-87

AUTHORIZING A REDUCTION IN THE ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION TO THE WASTEWATER CAPITAL RESERVE FUND (WCRF) FROM \$30,000 TO \$9,000 FOR THE BOLINAS COMMUNITY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT'S WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS:

1. Bolinas Community Public Utility District is now seeking to reduce the anticipated sewer service charges from approximately \$20.00 per month to approximately \$12.00 per month by lowering the annual contribution to the WCRF from \$30,000 to \$8,000.
2. Annual depreciation on the mechanical items in the Bolinas plant is approximately \$9,000, \$1,000 per year more than Bolinas proposes to place in the WCRF.
3. The proposed lower sewer use fee will still have a significant financial impact on the residents of Bolinas where the median annual income is estimated to be under \$8,000.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the annual contribution to the Wastewater Capital Reserve Fund for the Bolinas Community Public Utility District's wastewater collection and treatment project be reduced from \$30,000 to \$9,000.
2. That Bolinas be required to submit an annual audit to the Division of Water Quality.
