

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-100

AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
STATE BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR
ASSISTANCE IN DEVELOPING A STANDARD TOXICITY BIOASSAY

WHEREAS:

1. On July 17, 1974, the State Board executed an Interagency Agreement No. 3-2-77 with the Department of Fish and Game for assistance in developing a standard toxicity bioassay.
2. The first phase of the two-phase project has been completed and a report on that portion of the project was submitted on schedule.
3. The remaining work was delayed due to lack of availability of test fish species and late arrival of equipment.
4. The Department has requested an agreement extension to June 30, 1976, and will complete a full-year cycle of tests and prepare a final report within an augmentation of \$3,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Officer, or Deputy Executive Officer, be authorized to extend the Interagency Agreement No. 3-2-77 with the Department of Fish and Game to June 30, 1976, and augment the agreement by an amount not to exceed \$3,000, provided however, that all other terms and conditions are to remain in full force and effect.
