RESOLUTION NO. 79-86

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE  
A CONTRACT WITH THE U. S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY  
FOR ACCOMPLISHING PROJECTION OF SECTION LINES ON  
BASE MAPS

WHEREAS:


1. Currently published U. S. Geological Survey Quadrangle Maps contain section lines that are not complete for the Board's water right purposes.
2. The Board's rules require that diversion points and places of use in applications to appropriate water be defined with reference to subdivisions of the Public Land Survey or equivalent insofar as it is feasible to do so.
3. It is necessary to project section lines or provide an equivalent grid to fill in areas not covered on the quadrangle maps to accomplish description of points of diversion and places of use.
4. Projections are currently made by numerous governmental agencies and engineering consultants unilaterally under varying bases with resulting discrepancies and lack of agreement.
5. Excessive expenditures of money and manpower result from the duplication of effort and lack of uniformity under the existing system.
6. Numerous governmental agencies experience similar problems. The California State Mapping Advisory Committee has initiated coordination action to remedy the problem and it appears that USGS is the most logical agency to do the job.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board does direct and authorize its Executive Officer to enter into a contract with the U. S. Geological Survey for the expenditure of \$10,000 for this work during Fiscal Year 1979-80.
