RESOLUTION NO. 90-24

ACCEPTANCE OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, LOS ANGELES REGION'S PHASE III 205(j)(2) FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE "SANTA MONICA BAY PROJECT" (PROJECT)

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) pursuant to the terms of a Phase III 205(j)(2) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), provided \$150,000 in Phase III 205(j)(2) funds to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region to conduct the Phase III 205(j)(2) "Santa Monica Bay Project" (Project).
2. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Regional Board), has submitted to the State Board the Final Report entitled State of Santa Monica Bay (Final Report).
3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned Final Report conforms to the requirements of the EPA Phase III 205(j)(2) Project workplan.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Accepts the Final Report as completion of the Los Angeles Regional Board's Phase III 205(j)(2) Project workplan without committing any future funding for the proposed recommended actions.
2. Directs staff to transmit the Final Report to EPA as completion of the Project.
3. Directs staff to make known the availability of the Final Report to the appropriate Regional Boards, local agencies, and other interested parties.
