ACCEPTANCE OF THE SANTA ANA WATERSHED PROJECT AUTHORITY'S PHASE II 205(j)(2) FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE "SANTA ANA-SAN JACINTO BASIN GROUND WATER NITRATE STUDY" PROJECT (PROJECT)

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase II 205(j)(2) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board), provided \$56,000 to the Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority (SAWPA) to investigate nitrate impacts to the Santa Ana-San Jacinto Ground Water Basins.
- The State Board allocated in 1987 \$50,000 in bond funds to complete the Project.
- 3. SAWPA has completed and submitted the two-volume Final Report to the State Board entitled 205(j) Reclamation Study and Nitrate Impact Study Report.
- 4. The State Board has found that the Final Report conforms to the requirements of the Phase II grant and the project workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Accepts the Final Report as completion of the SAWPA Phase II 205(j)(2) Project.
- Directs State Board staff to transmit the Final Report to EPA as completion of the SAWPA Phase II 205(j)(2) "Santa Ana-San Jacinto Ground Water Nitrate Study" Project.
- Directs State Board staff to transmit a notice of Final Report availability to the appropriate California Regional Water Quality Control Boards, local agencies, and other interested parties.
