STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-55

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE, EXECUTE, AND AMEND, AS NECESSARY, ONE OR MORE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS (IAs) BETWEEN THE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES REGARDING THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY'S ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION AND WASTE MANAGEMENT FIVE-YEAR PLAN

WHEREAS:

- The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has established an Environmental Restoration and Waste Management Five-Year Plan to bring all of its facilities into compliance with the letter and spirit of California's and federal environmental laws, regulations, and requirements.
- DOE success in this endeavor depends in part on coordination with State agencies.
- DOE and the Department of Health Services (DHS) will enter into an Agreement-In-Principle which designates DHS as lead State agency for the DOE project.
- DOE is providing financial resources through DHS to reimburse the Board and Regional Boards approximately \$50,000 for initial program development from July 1, 1990 through November 30, 1990 and approximately \$482,672 for subsequent water quality oversight of DOE environmental compliance activities from December 1, 1990 through November 30, 1991.
- IAs between the Board and DHS have been drafted which provides such funds to the State and Regional Boards and represents a commitment by the Board and DHS to coordinate their respective oversight of DOE environmental compliance activities on a timely, constructive, and fiscally sound basis.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes and directs the Executive Director to negotiate. execute, and amend, as necessary, one or more Interagency Agreements with DHS regarding the U.S. Department of Energy's Environmental Restoration and Waste Management Five-Year Plan.
