STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-58

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR LABORATORY ANALYTICAL SERVICES FOR THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE NINE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARDS IN FY 1990-91

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) and the nine California Regional Water Quality Control Boards (Regional Boards) have a continuing need for laboratory analyses of water quality samples taken as part of their regulatory programs.
- 2. The Regional Boards' use of water quality sampling and analysis is an important part of the State's regulatory program.
- 3. The Department of Health Services, which has provided such services since 1976, is capable of and amenable to providing such services in FY 1990-91.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement with the Department of Health Services for an amount not to exceed \$309,660 in FY 1990-91 General Fund monies and \$14,000 in FY 1990-91 Old Bond Fund monies for State and Regional Board laboratory analytical services through June 30, 1991, subject to availability of funds.
