RESOLUTION NO. 90-61

APPROVAL OF THE SECTION 205(j)(2) PROGRAM
ADMINISTRATION CONTINUATION GRANT

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) administers the federal Clean Water Act Sections 205(j)(2) and 604(b) Water Quality Management Planning Program in California.
2. The State Board 205(j)(2) Program Administration activity is funded under an annually renewable Continuation Grant from the overall Sections 205(j)(2) and 604(b) allocation awarded to the State by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
3. The State Board must request the Continuation Grant for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1990 by August 1, 1990.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Requests EPA to award a Continuation Grant for FFY 1991 to the State Board for 205(j)(2) Program Administration in an amount up to \$761,919.
2. Directs staff to transmit the State Board's FFY 1991 Section 205(j)(2) Program Administration Workplan to EPA.
3. Authorizes the Executive Director, or his designee, to apply for the Continuation Grant and to accept the grant when offered.
