STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-99

APPROVAL OF CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, SAN DIEGO REGION (SAN DIEGO REGIONAL BOARD), RESOLUTION NO. 88-91 AND ADDENDA NOS. 1 AND 2 TO THE RESOLUTION GRANTING CONDITIONAL WAIVERS OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TEMPORARY USE OF RECLAIMED WATER

WHEREAS:

- 1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Regional Board), adopted Resolution No. 88-91 on August 29, 1988, providing for "Conditional Waivers of Waste Discharge Requirements and Water Reclamation Requirements for Selected Water Reclamation Projects During Drought Conditions"; and
- 2. The San Diego Regional Board extended the authority to grant waivers of WDRs and water reclamation requirements for selected water reclamation projects during drought conditions by adopting Addendum No. 1 to Resolution No. 88-91 on July 10, 1989; and
- 3. The San Diego Regional Board further extended the authority to grant waivers of WDRs and water reclamation requirements for selected water reclamation projects during drought conditions by adopting Addendum No. 2 to Resolution No. 88-91 on June 4, 1990; and
- 4. California Water Code (CWC) Section 13245.5 requires that the State Water Resources Control Board approve Regional Board guidelines before those guidelines can become effective; and
- The Office of Chief Counsel has determined that Regional Board WDR waiver policies (waiver policies) constitute guidelines; and
- 6. State Board Resolution No. 73-42 required that the State Board also approve waiver policies; and
- 7. Pursuant to CWC Section 13245.5 and State Board Resolution No. 73-42, the San Diego Regional Board has submitted the attached waiver policies for State Board consideration; and
- 8. These waiver policies are consistent with all applicable laws, regulations, and the Administrative Procedures Manual.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the waste discharge requirement and water reclamation requirement waiver policies adopted by the San Diego Regional Board under its Resolution No. 88-91 and Addenda Nos. 1 and 2 thereof.
