STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-116

DIRECTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO STANDARD AGREEMENT NO. 8-139-120-0 WITH CLEMENT ASSOCIATES TO CONTINUE REVIEW OF THE BASELINE PUBLIC HEALTH EVALUATIONS (BPHEs) AND FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS) RISK ASSESSMENTS OF THE MULTI-SITE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT (MSCA) SUPERFUND SITES

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Regional Board) is responsible for regulating toxic spills and underground storage tank leak cleanups to protect the South Bay drinking water supplies from contamination.
- The Regional Board has lead responsibility for cleanup of 20 Superfund sites.
- 3. The MSCA grant special conditions and federal Superfund law and regulations require review of BPHEs and FS risk assessments prior to adoption of final cleanup plans for Superfund sites.
- 4. Clement Associates, which was awarded a contract to perform the work, has found deficiencies in the BPHEs and FS risk assessments from dischargers, requiring additional review and comments.
- Additional time and funding is needed to complete all the work in progress and to meet MSCA time schedules.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute an amendment to Standard Agreement No. 8-139-120-0 with Clement Associates to continue review of BPHEs and FS risk assessments through March 13, 1992, in an amount not to exceed \$89,465.
