STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2004 - 0047

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND/OR AMEND A FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 205(j) GRANT

WHEREAS:

- 1. Section 205(j) of the federal Clean Water Act (CWA) authorizes states to reserve up to one percent of their annual Title II Clean Water Construction Grant allocation for water quality management planning activities. Beginning in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1989, CWA section 604(b) supplemented CWA section 205(j)(2) to maintain such funding.
- 2. A total of \$1,073,800 will be available in FFY 2004 for funding the water quality management planning program from CWA section 604(b), of which 40 percent is typically passed through to local agencies for projects.
- 3. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) has been granted a waiver from the pass-through requirement from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), the federal granting agency, and will use the entire 205(j) grant to support its overall water quality planning program in FFY 2004.
- 4. Many water quality planning activities administered by SWRCB have been severely undersupported. These include refinement of designated beneficial uses of the State's waters, establishment of sound water quality objectives to protect those uses, and other important activities related to the Division of Water Quality's workload associated with developing and processing Total Maximum Daily Loads.
- 5. In-kind services with USEPA, as well as staff resources from the 205(j) grant, will contribute significantly to meeting these needs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

SWRCB:

- 1. Approves the use of the entire CWA section 205(j) grant to support DWQ's overall water quality planning program.
- 2. Authorizes the Executive Director or designee to apply for and accept the FFY 2004 Phase XVIII water quality management planning project grant under CWA sections 205(j) and 604(b).
- 3. Authorizes the Executive Director or designee to approve the final Phase XVIII water quality management planning workplans.

4. Authorizes the issuance of in-kind services with USEPA and amendments in accordance with the workplans to implement projects subject to the availability of federal funding.
