## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2006 – 0041

COMMITTING CLEAN BEACHES INITIATIVE
GRANT FUNDS TO THE COUNTY OF ORANGE (COUNTY) FOR THE POCHE BEACH
ULTRAVIOLET LIGHT BACTERIA DISINFECTION SYSTEM (PROJECT) AT POCHE BEACH;
CLEAN BEACHES INITIATIVE (CBI) GRANT PROGRAM; CBI PROJECT NO. 304

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The Watershed, Clean Beaches, and Water Quality Act (Act) (Public Resources Code §30901) was signed into law on September 20, 2002. The Act appropriated \$46 million from Proposition 40 for additional CBI grants to help local agencies, non-profit organizations, and public agencies implement projects that protect and restore California's coastal water:
- 2. The CBI funds appropriated in the Act are available for encumbrance up to December 31, 2006;
- 3. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), on April 21, 2005, adopted the CBI Competitive Location List which included Poche Beach;
- 4. The Clean Beaches Task Force reviewed the County's proposed Project at Poche Beach, and recommended it for funding at the October 12, 2005 meeting; and
- 5. The County has prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration, which has been reviewed and considered, and State Water Board staff has determined that the project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption from CEQA requirements, and will not result in any significant water

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approves a grant for the County's Project not to exceed \$1,500,000 from the *Act*.
