STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2006-0057

COMMITTING CLEAN BEACHES INITIATIVE GRANT FUNDS TO THE CITY OF LONG BEACH (CITY) FOR COLORADO LAGOON BEACHES (PROJECT); CLEAN BEACHES INITIATIVE (CBI) GRANT PROGRAM; CBI PROJECT NO. 310

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Watershed, Clean Beaches, and Water Quality Act (Act) (Public Resources Code §30901) was signed into law on September 20, 2002. The Act appropriated \$46 million from Proposition 40 for additional CBI grants to help non-profit organizations and public agencies implement projects that protect and restore California's coastal water;
- 2. The CBI funds appropriated in the Act are available for encumbrance up to December 31, 2006;
- 3. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), on April 21, 2005, adopted the CBI Competitive Location List which included Colorado Lagoon Beaches;
- 4. The Clean Beaches Task Force reviewed the City's proposed Project at Colorado Lagoon Beaches, and recommended it for funding at the December 13, 2005 meeting; and
- 5. The City will prepare a Negative Declaration for the Project as part of the grant agreement. No work identified in the agreement that is subject to CEQA will proceed until the City has received environmental clearance from Division of Financial Assistance staff.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approves a grant for the City's Project not to exceed \$3,823,868 from the *Act*.
