BY THE BOARD:

On October 15, 1974, the Union Oil Company (petitioner) submitted a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) requesting review of Order No. 74-68 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region. The petitioner additionally requests the State Board to stay the effect of Order No. 74-68 pending disposition of the petition.

The State Board finds that:

- 1. The petition raises issues appropriate for review.
- 2. The petition does not establish either substantial harm to the petitioner or to the public interest if a stay is not granted, nor lack of substantial harm to other interested persons or to the public interest if the stay is granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The petition to review Order No. 74-68 be accepted for review;

2. The stay of Order No. 74-68 be denied without prejudice to subsequent reapplication for stay in the event that petitioner alleges facts demonstrating actual inability to meet interim requirements on grease and oil.
