<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The purpose of this project is to install an ADA compliant gangway and additional dock space.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Installing a prefabricated, 80' long and 4' wide, aluminum gangway, designed to meet ADA guidelines;</li><li>• Conducting minor modifications to the existing walkway for landside attachment of the gangway; and,</li><li>• Prefabricating a small concrete or wood dock and attaching it to the existing Sea Landing docks to create a landing for the ADA compliant gangway.</li></ul> <p>No compensatory mitigation is planned for this project.</p> <p>The City of Santa Barbara filed a Categorical Exemption on November 10, 2015.</p>
