RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, CONSTRUCTION DEWATERING PLA65 (03-33382) COON CREEK BRIDGE PROJECT, PLACER COUNTY

On 18 April 2013, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (Order 2003-003-DWQ) to California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). The Notice of Applicability was for the temporary discharge of groundwater encountered during construction of the State Route 65 bridge across Coon Creek between Nelson Lane and W. Wise Road in Placer County.

Your Notice of Termination dated 3 December 2013 states that the discharge phase of the project has been completed and you wish to terminate coverage under the General WDRs. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ is hereby rescinded.
