RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, CONSTRUCTION DEWATERING SUT99 (03-406604) RIEGO ROAD PROJECT, SUTTER COUNTY

On 27 July 2013, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (Order 2003-003-DWQ) to California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). The Notice of Applicability was for the temporary discharge of groundwater encountered during the construction of a 5-column bent and six overhead sign locations surrounding the intersection of State Route 99 and Riego Road in Sutter County.

Your Notice of Termination dated 21 March 2014 states that the discharge phase of the project has been completed and you wish to terminate coverage under the General WDRs. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ is hereby rescinded.
